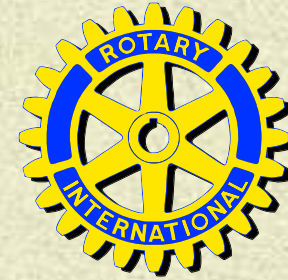

Don't forget to get measured for the new club shirts in particular if you are coming to the Conference in May.

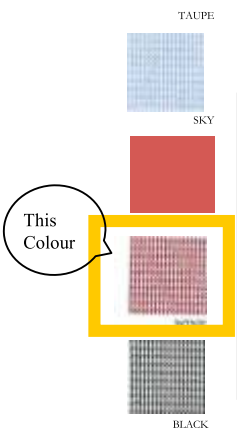
